

# 2018 YOUTH/YOUNG ADULT MISSION TRIP SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

## **Youth/Young Adult Applicant Qualifying Criteria:**

- A. Be a full-time student (for students up to the age of 30).
- B. Be a Potomac Conference constituent member (or the child of a member). Simply being enrolled in a Potomac Conference School does not meet this criteria.
- C. Is currently attending a Potomac Conference Church
- D. Submit two recommendation forms (attached to this document) from any of the following: Your church Pastor/Youth Pastor, church Elder, church Youth Leader, or church school Teacher. No relatives please.
- E. Provide verification of being involved in your local church/school's Out-reach ministry or evangelism meetings during the past 12 months.
- F. Submit to the Youth Department a post-trip 2 page report (with pictures) within 30 days of returning home.
- G. Scholarships will be awarded by a review committee based on degree of church/school involvement, cost of the trip, financial support from the local church and nature of the project.

## **Funding Procedure: SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED BASED ON AVAILABLE POTOMAC PARTNER FUNDS AS OF February 20, 2018.**

- A. Submit the Mission Trip Application to the Potomac Conference Youth Department. For **2018 Spring** trips, the application **deadline is December 19, 2017**. For **Summer 2018** Mission Trips, the deadline to submit the application is by **April 16, 2018**.
- B. The Youth Department will review all applications received by the appropriate deadlines and will assign scholarship amounts.
- C. Notification of scholarship award will be sent to the applicant **by email**, confirming the acceptance or denial of application and informing the applicant of the amount of the award.
- D. The scholarship award will be mailed directly to the mission trip sponsoring organization.
- E. Please notify the Youth Dept. of cancellations as soon as possible. We will ask that any award that has been given be returned to the Youth Dept.
