Master Guide Recertification in the North American Division will take place every three years for candidates that are currently active within a conference, and within a year for candidates who change conferences/union or come from another division. In order to obtain recertification, you must:

PRE-REQUIREMENTS:

1. Be a Master Guide.
2. Provide a church statement from your local church pastor, elder or church clerk stating that the candidate is fit to be considered as a Master Guide.
3. Have a current First Aid and CPR certification.
4. Meet all requirements for the Child Protection Course and corresponding background check as established by your conference.
5. Have a current Basic Staff Training Certification in one of the following:
 - a. Adventurer Ministries
 - b. Pathfinder Ministries
 - c. Youth Ministries

REQUIRED SEMINARS:

1. Attend a seventy-five-minute seminar on each of the following topics:
 - a. Redefining Leadership
 - b. Conflict Resolution (as it relates to: dealing with parents, difficult staff, church board, ethnic groups, etc.)
 - c. Cultural Differences
 - d. Child Protection and Risk Management as it refers to Adventurers, Pathfinders and Youth Ministries
 - e. De-Escalation (Identifying signs that could lead to a crisis in behavior)
 - f. Disability Awareness
 - g. Conference Specific Programing

2. Write three goals that you would like to accomplish during the next three years.

REQUIRED HANDS ON WORK

Demonstrate The following skills:

1. Be able to pitch 4-man tent.
2. Be able to execute the Drilling and Marching Basic Commands.
3. Be able to demonstrate the execution of five (5) knots and one (1) lashing.
4. Put together a program for a 2-hour club meeting.
5. Demonstrate how to properly fold, carry and place the flag.
6. Plan a weekend campout which includes a drawing of the camp layout.
7. Be able to demonstrate at least three first aid bandages.
